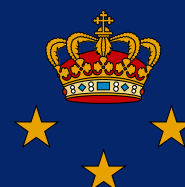
What can we expect from Flemming's term of office? Well lots of sailing that is

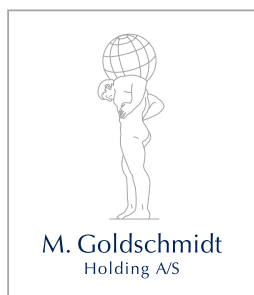
